CONDITIONS

1. The holder of this Approval shall comply with all the conditions of the requirements for the grant of approval and the requirements for the maintenance of approval applicable to each of the matters specified in the Schedule.
2. The holder of this Approval shall comply with the terms of the Maintenance Organisation Exposition submitted by him and approved by the Civil Aviation Authority (herein referred to as 'the Exposition').
3. The holder of this Approval shall not furnish a report on work done or issue a Certificate of Maintenance Review or Certificate of Release to Service, under the terms of this Approval, unless the work reported on has been done or the maintenance, overhaul, repair, replacement, modification or inspection as the case may be has been carried out at locations specified in the Exposition.
4. The authorisation of certifying personnel in respect of aircraft listed in paragraph 14 of Airworthiness Notice No 10 must be in accordance with the requirements of British Civil Airworthiness Requirement (BCAR) Chapter A8-13 Supplement 2. This Authorisation shall be limited to the scope of work defined in the Exposition.
5. Qualification requirements for the authorisation of certifying personnel in respect of aircraft not listed in paragraph 14 of Airworthiness No. 10 are as follows,
 - (i) an appropriately type rated Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's licence, or
 - (ii) the requirements defined in CAP 360 Part 2, Chapter 2 paragraph 2.2.

Signatories for the certification of Scheduled Maintenance Inspections and Certificates of Maintenance Review are as defined in the respective Aircraft Maintenance Schedule approval document (AD 271).

Qualification requirements for the authorisation of certifying personnel in respect of component maintenance are as defined in the Maintenance Organisation Exposition.
